1. PKP is a sovereign licensed profession in New Zealand with legislation on the books in over 11 other countries as well. It is a recognized profession by the governments and insurance's in multiple countries as well.
2. Approved TFH text teaches 3 mental/emotion components per each of the 5-Elements.
Approved PKP text uses 218 mental/emotion components on the 5-Element chart alone, the Amygdala chart has 93 more. There are other charts available as well.
3. PKP protocol routinely evaluates any of over 2000 possible permutations of any 1 of these mental/emotion components.
(presence/absence of = 2) (positive/negative =2) (direction 8x8 = 64) (plane of existence =9) $2 \times 2 \times 64 \times 9 = 2304$
 $2304 \times 311 = 716,544$ routine mental/emotional component permutations.
