

## In This Issue: Five ICOHA students attend Faculty Training in Australia

### FAB 5 return from FAC 1

Five students from the USA attended the ICPKP's Faculty Admission Course level 1 (FAC 1) in Sydney Australia this month.

This program is a mandatory prerequisite for being able to teach the ICPKP college program. It is offered only once every two years worldwide.

With the addition of this five this now gives ICOHA a total of eight college faculty/faculty in training who have been trained directly from two of the founders of kinesiology.

ICOHA also has three other teaching staff who were trained by the Dewes at the K-Power ITW in Canada in 2008.

This makes ICOHA one of the largest college faculties in the world who have learned from and proven their skills to the original masters of the art.

The FAC programs are a very intense review of all of the material covered during the first Academic Year of the program. This material is presented both as review but also with suggestions and ideas on how to present the material so students can understand it better.

In addition to the review of the material candidates were required to perform three 20 minute teaching presentations on a topic from the BKP material, and give three 2 minute muscle presentations to

prove their teaching skills.

Peer review was offered from both all other participants and from all Senior Faculty present.

In order to prove clinical competencies they were also required to do three observed full protocol balances in front of the Dewe's and other Senior Faculty.

Administration of oral and practical board exams was also covered both theoretically and then

again live in person with each candidate undergoing the exams personally, that in addition to the written exam they had to take to qualify for teaching credentials.

As much as it 12-14 days every day they did get a half day at one point and Kelli and Shari were able to attend a performance of Shakespeare "A Midsummer's Night Dream" at the famous Sydney Opera House.
